“The new lightweight helmet is designed to exceed the ballistic fragmentation resistance as defined and determined by most Armies, but with a significant weight reduction of approximately 20%, which means above 0.5 pounds as compared to the older one”, adds Yoav Kapah, one of the world's most recognized Ballistic Protection Engineers conducting the Special R&D Program.
